Subject: Item 6.d: Point2Point Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program FFY19 Funding

Action Recommended: Conduct public hearing. Provide feedback to staff.

Purpose

This agenda item requests a public hearing and MPC feedback on a proposal to amend the Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) to program \$143,288 of MPO discretionary STBG-U funds for Point2point's FFY19 Regional Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program.

Background and Discussion

Point2point requests funding for three district SRTS programs in order to maintain the current level of SRTS K-8 programming in the 4J, Bethel and Springfield school districts through federal fiscal year 2019.

The Regional SRTS program's mission is to serve a diverse community of parents, students and organizations: advocating for and promoting the use of transportation options including active transportation and the practice of safe bicycling and walking to and from schools throughout the Central Lane MPO area.

Public Involvement

A public comment period on the proposed amendment is open from March 30, 2018 through April 28, 2018. A public hearing is scheduled for the April 5, 2018 MPC meeting, with action on the request scheduled for the May 3, 2018 meeting.

At its March 21, 2018 meeting, the MPO's Transportation Planning Committee (TPC) discussed the proposal to program the STBG-U funds, and unanimously recommended consideration of the proposal.
