NorthWest Senior & Disability Services (NWSDS) is seeking proposals for the provision of Food Preparation and Delivery services for the Senior Meals Programs operating in Marion, Polk, Yamhill, Linn, Benton, Lincoln, and Lane County, Oregon. Only those responding to this request by the date and time indicated will be eligible to submit a proposal. NWSDS may reject any response not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and may reject for good cause any or all bids upon a finding of the agency that it is in the public interest to do so. It is anticipated this contract will be for the provision of 424,000 fresh meals and 114,000 frozen meals between July 1, 2019 and June 30, 2020.
