Older Americans Act Contracts for Services FY 2009-10

Background:

At its April meeting, the LCOG Executive Committee approved the 2009-10 update to the Area Plan on Aging and Disability Services in Lane County. This plan contained several components, one of which was a budget for services for the 2009-10 fiscal year (i.e. July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2010). This memo is to share information with the LCOG Board regarding the identities of the agencies and organizations with which S&DS will contract in 2009-10 to provide services which are not delivered directly by S&DS staff.

*Based on previous Board actions, S&DS will procure the following services in 2009-10 through a three-agency consortium (involving LCOG, Oregon Cascades West COG, and Northwest Senior & Disability Services): Home Care (Addus), Personal Care (Addus), and Food Services (Bateman). Both of these contracts are being continued through September 30, 2009 to allow for a clearer budget picture. The contracts will then be renegotiated.

**The Metro Meals on Wheels contract with the American Red Cross has been extended through September 30, 2009 at the levels listed above. Any difference between the current rates and any rates negotiated for the remainder of the year (October 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 will be applied to the actual meals served July 1, 2009 through September 30, 2009.
