2010-11 Update to the 2008-11 Area Plan on Aging and Disability Services for Lane County

Action Recommended: Adopt Area Plan

Background:

In accordance with federal and state policy, S&DS is required to help create and maintain a comprehensive and coordinated service delivery system to meet the needs of older and disabled people of Lane County. To document its work toward this goal, S&DS is also required to develop an Area Plan on Aging and Disability Services. The Area Plan is a multi-year document, with annual updates. Program Year 2010-11 (July 1, 2010 - June 30, 2011) represents the third full year of the Area Plan cycle which began in January 2008 and runs through December 2011.

The development of the 2010-11 Component to the 2008-2011 Area Plan was a joint effort involving staff and members of S&DS' Planning & Budget Committee, a standing committee of LCOG's two advisory councils. The attached document describes the process and the resulting recommendations for funding of services through the Older Americans Act and Oregon Project Independence. Both the Senior Services Advisory Council and the Disability Services Advisory Council received and accepted this report at their meetings earlier this year. On Thursday, June 10th, the LCOG Executive Committee heard a report on the topic, and recommended approval by the LCOG Board.

Requested Action:

1. That the LCOG Board adopt the 2010-11 Update to S&DS' 2008-11 Area Plan on Aging and Disability Services; and
2. That S&DS staff be authorized to submit the Plan Update to the Oregon Department of Human Services.
