SUBJECT: Action on the 2011-12 Update to the Area Plan on Aging and Disability Services for Lane County

In accordance with federal and state policy, S&DS is required to help create and maintain a comprehensive and coordinated service delivery system to meet the needs of older and disabled people of Lane County. To document its work toward this goal, S&DS is required to develop an Area Plan on Aging and Disability Services. The Area Plan is a multi-year document, with annual updates. The Area Plan cycle which began in January 2008 has now been extended for an additional year, through December 2012.

The development of the 2011-12 Component to the Area Plan was a joint effort involving staff and members of S&DS' Planning & Budget Committee, a standing committee of LCOG's two advisory councils. The attached document describes the process and the resulting recommendations for funding of services through the Older Americans Act and Oregon Project Independence.

Requested Action:

The Senior Services Advisory Council recommends that the LCOG Board approve the following:

1. That LCOG adopt the 2011 Update to S&DS' Area Plan on Aging and Disability Services, as presented to the Senior Services Advisory Council; and
2. That S&DS staff be authorized to submit the Plan Update to the Oregon Department of Human Services.
