## **Green Group: Final 5**

---

- Feel safe:
  - From crime
  - Safe air / water
  - Safe roads
  - Emergency response
  - Public health capacity
  - Coordination / interoperability between agencies
- Policy makers who reach out and listen to the public:
  - Have a modern mechanism for the public to tell policy makers what they want
  - Have a way for the public to get good, trusted information  
(this addresses safety, quality of life, infrastructure, health, economy, environment)
- Communities help each other out and identify / avoid unintended consequences of their actions
- Create and maintain a diverse set of jobs – no unemployment
- Health and human services system that meets needs, is sustainable, is coordinated.
- Have communications system to identify needs and provide information to community

## **Green Group: Preliminary Outcomes**

---

- Recognize unintended consequences of failure to communicate
- Communication system to better inform each other about what we're doing, especially identify impacts from actions
- Sense of community / communication between local governments and State legislature
- Liaison / connection between civics and real world
- Meet the needs of senior and disabled population
- Public and policy makers educated about human services – how to get them, need good information system
- More effective H&HS delivery and information system
- Support families providing services to each other
- Public safety:
  - Safe
  - Feel safe at home, in neighborhood, at school, on streets
  - Response: 24/7 Emergency
  - Medical / Ambulance Response

- Fire – faster response / complete coverage, stable funding
  - Clean air / clean water

  - Public health department that can adequately respond to need

- Have a trusted public information system for the public to get information about what is happening
- We use relevant communication methods used by public

---

### Human Services

Human services are well coordinated and easy to access and utilize

### Economic Development

Lane County has a coordinated regional business initiative

### Communication

Lane County leverages technology to provide open, inter-jurisdictional communication

### Infrastructure

Lane County provides a clear path for jurisdictions to obtain cost-effective service for infrastructure needs based on “abundance mentality” vs. “scarcity mentality.”

## **Red Group: Preliminary Outcomes**

---

### Human Services

- Whole child education
- Lifelong
- Strong families

### Public Safety

- System connected to resources for support “integrated”...seamless integration
- Mutual accountability between agencies, ownership of problem working with person. Holistic
- Community perceived as “safe”
- Solvent EMS
- Elimination of urban/rural divide...a regional approach

- Adequately funded – no competition
- Efficient and appropriate use of money – financial accountability

### Infrastructure

- All jurisdictions have a voice
- Clear path for cities to obtain infrastructure including templates, cooperation among agencies, support from other bodies
- Regional housing, commercial, industrial lands plan
- Find regional intersecting common ground
- Reconcile differing visions, perspectives, needs, philosophies
- Buy-in commitment towards success for all
- Abundance mentality vs. scarcity mentality

### Communication & Governance
