The library is located at 100 West 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue (between Olive and Charnelton)

#### Parking Around the Library:

Library Parking Level: 64 spaces below the library at 75 cents/hour (3-hour max)

Broadway Place: West corners of Charnelton & Broadway at 75 cents/hour

Overpark: West corners of 10<sup>th</sup> & Oak at 75 cents/hour

Parcade: NW corner of 8<sup>th</sup> & Willamette at 75 cents/hour

10<sup>th</sup> & Olive Surface Lot: Across from Library at \$1/hour or \$5/all day

On-Street Metered Parking at 75 cents/hour
