Mid-Biennium Review and Update

**Action Recommended:** None. Information only.

### **Issue Statement**

MPC approved the current two-year UPWP in April 2009 and requested that an annual review be scheduled for April 2010 to provide an opportunity to discuss progress in each of the program areas. This agenda item provides the CAC with a status report on the two-year UPWP and recommendations for minor amendments to account for new work items that have emerged over the past year. Staff will be seeking MPC approval of the UPWP amendments and associated STP-U funding at the April MPC meeting.

### **Background**

The FY 2010-2011 UPWP was developed by the partner agencies of the MPO working with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), the Federal Highway Administration, and the Federal Transit Administration. This was the first year that the Central Lane MPO developed a two-year work program. The purpose of the two-year plan was to provide the public and policy makers with an understanding of the larger planning horizon and to more efficiently utilize limited staff resources.
