Subject: MPC 6.a: Central Lane MPO FY2020/FY2021 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

**Action Recommended:** Approve Resolution 2019-03

### **Background and Discussion**

Each year, the partner agencies of the MPO work with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration to update and adopt the federally-required unified work program for transportation planning in the MPO. The UPWP included as Exhibit A to Resolution 2019-03 included with this memo covers Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021 and contains the following:

- Planning tasks in seven core program areas to be conducted by the MPO and the MPO member agencies;
- Federally funded transportation studies as well as all relevant state and locally planning activities conducted without federal funds;
- Funding sources (when known or specified) for each program area; and
- The agency or agencies responsible for each task or study.

The draft UPWP was presented to the MPC at the April 4, 2019 meeting. The public hearing held at that meeting and the 30-day public comment period closing April 28<sup>th</sup> have resulted in no comments on the draft as of the date of this memo. At its April 17, 2019 meeting, the Transportation Planning Committee (TPC) unanimously recommended MPC adoption of the UPWP.
