Issue Statement

Information/Update

Lane Transit District (LTD) is excited to provide an oral update at the MPC meeting on three projects recently implemented, or in the process of implementation. All have significant opportunities and impacts to potentially positively affect transportation behavior.

Student Transit Pass Program (STPP)

EmGo

On August 26, 2019, EmGo was launched to provide on-demand service within the Eugene downtown core. This one-year pilot program is a partnership of LTD, City of Eugene, Lane Council of Government, and Lane County. https://www.ltd.org/system-map/route_EmGo/
