**Metropolitan Policy Committee (MPC)**

*May 7, 2020*

- Approved FY21 Addendum to the MPO's FY2020/2021 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and funding for FY21 UPWP activities.
- Approved the MPO's FY21-24 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) and accompanying Air Quality Conformity Determination (AQCD).
- Approved a letter of support for an Oregon International Port of Coos Bay grant proposal.

**Metropolitan Policy Committee (MPC)**

*June 4, 2020*

- Heard a staff presentation, and held a public hearing, on proposed MPO discretionary funding for transportation projects in FY22-24.
- Heard a report on the Oregon Land Conservation and Development Commission's (LCDC) consideration of new rulemaking for implementation of the Statewide Transportation Strategy and reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
- Heard a brief update on Safe Lane Coalition activities.

## **Lane Economic Committee (LEC)**

*March 9, 2020*

- Heard update on Small Business Development Center from Eric Lind, a former long time-area banker and now business advisor for the Center.
- Mark Bodie, LEC Chair, began the roundtable discussion, focusing on the economic effects of COVID-19.
