MTIP Amendments
Transportation Planning Committee

The following TIP actions were approved by MPO staff, or will be approved upon completion of public comment period:

21327 - Coburg

Coburg Loop- N. Coburg Industrial Way

Description: Construct a shared-use path to promote the use of alternative forms of transportation.

Funding: \$699,877 (STBG)

Amendment: Add 2022 Right of Way phase using \$2,000 of local funds

Public comment period complete February 5

21322 – LCOG

Transportation Options program (SFY 21)

Description: LCOG funding to promote & encourage the use of alternative transportation options in Lane County during state fiscal year 2021

Funding: \$161,022.36 (Fix-It R2, Statewide TDM)

Note: \$74,632.32 of federal funds is for rideshare and require no match

Amendment: Add \$60,000 of Statewide TDM funds and change the Rideshare amount to 15 percent of total federal funds.

20990 – LTD

Diamond Express Vehicle Replacement (LTD)

Description: Service connects Oakridge and Westfir communities to the Eugene/Springfield metro area, and Amtrak. Current vehicle has failed and back-up vehicle is nearing its useful life.

Funding: \$330,000 (5309, 5339, CMAQ-Oakridge, local)

Amendment: Increase Oakridge CMAQ amount from \$130,000 (federal + match) to \$141,580 (federal + match) to agree with the IGA. Existing local overmatch will now be utilized for federal match. Total project estimate will remain \$330,000.
