ADOPTING THE CENTRAL LANE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP)

WHEREAS, the Lane Council of Governments (LCOG) has been designated by the State of Oregon as the official Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Central Lane region; and

WHEREAS, the LCOG Board has delegated responsibility for MPO policy functions to the Metropolitan Policy Committee (MPC), a committee of officials from Eugene, Springfield, Coburg, Lane County, Lane Transit District, and ODOT; and

WHEREAS, federal regulations require the MPO to adopt a long-range regional transportation plan consistent with guidelines set forth by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration; and

WHEREAS, the regional transportation plan reflects a multimodal evaluation of transportation, socioeconomic, environmental, and financial impacts of the overall plan, including all major transportation investments; and

WHEREAS, the regional transportation plan also reflects land use, economic, and other community plans; and

WHEREAS, an Air Quality Conformity Determination for the RTP is prepared and demonstrates compliance with the Clean Air Act; and

WHEREAS, the draft 2045 RTP document has been published or otherwise made readily available for public review including an electronically accessible format on the MPO's website; and

WHEREAS, a public review and comment period has been conducted, and the MPC has approved the public review process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

ATTEST:

THAT, the 2045 RTP has been prepared according to federal regulations and addresses the related corrective actions issued in the MPO's "Transportation Management Area Planning Certification Review" which was issued October 30, 2019; and

THAT, the MPC adopts the 2045 RTP as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to and incorporated within this resolution by reference.
