Subject: MPC6.a: Programming of Redistribution Funds

Action Requested: Approve Resolution 2024-01, programming federal funds and amending the Transportation Improvement Program

Issue Statement

The Central Lane Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has received roughly \$1M of federal redistribution Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds and have reviewed proposals to utilize these funds. Transportation Planning Committee (TPC) has provided a funding recommendation to MPC.

Discussion

Central Lane MPO has received \$1,049,387 of federal funding to be obligated to projects by September 2025. Four funding proposals were submitted for consideration. TPC has prepared a funding recommendation after considering how well each project supports the regional primary funding considerations, the federal performance targets, air quality conformity, Title VI & environmental justice, and other criteria.
