WALKTOBER




Do you like walking for fun, exercise, or errands? Or wish you had more reasons to walk? Mark your calendar for Walktober - a month filled with walking in Lane County!

SENIOR MEALS OPENS MORE CAFE 60s

The Senior Meals Program reopened more Café 60 locations in September! They include Oakridge, Junction City, Creswell, and Cottage Grove. Reservations are required for each location and should be made at least one week in advance. Walk-ins will be accommodated as long as meals are available. Service time varies by location, and meals are available to people who are 60 years of age or older and their spouses, regardless of age at no cost*. If you are under age 60, we welcome you to dine with us for \$8.00 per meal.

*Voluntary donations are welcome, but not required. Contributions directly impact our ability to provide nutritious meals, friendly visits, and regular wellness checks to seniors in our community.
